- 3 Rhythm Strauss's rhythmic choices often mirrored the emotional intensity of his music He employed a wide range of rhythmic patterns from simple and flowing to complex and driving He often used syncopation and irregular meters to create a sense of rhythmic excitement Example In the famous Ride of the Valkyries from *Die Walküre* Strauss uses a driving rhythmic pattern to create a sense of power and urgency evoking the image of the Valkyries riding through the sky
- 4 Timbre Strauss was a master orchestrator using the unique sonic qualities of different instruments to create a rich and varied soundscape He often employed unusual instrumental combinations such as the use of the English horn in *Der Rosenkavalier* to create unique and memorable musical effects Example In *Also Sprach Zarathustra* Strauss's famous tone poem he uses a wide array of orchestral instruments including trumpets timpani and horns to create a sense of cosmic grandeur and awe

approaching disability as a cultural construction rather than a medical pathology this book studies the impact of disability and concepts of disability on composers performers and listeners with disabilities as well as on discourse about music and works of music themselves for composers with disabilities like beethoven delius and schumann awareness of the disability sharply inflects critical reception for performers with disabilities such as itzhak perlman and evelyn glennie the performance of disability and the performance of music are deeply intertwined for listeners with disabilities extraordinary bodies and minds may give rise to new ways of making sense of music in the stories that people tell about music and in the stories that music itself tells disability has long played a central but unrecognized role some of these stories are narratives of overcoming the triumph of the human spirit over adversity but others are more nuanced tales of accommodation and acceptance of life with a non normative body or mind in all of these ways music both reflects and constructs disability

broken beauty illustrates how disability is right at the core of musical modernism it is one of the things that musical modernism is fundamentally about the most characteristic features of musical modernism fractured forms immobilized harmonies conflicting textural layers radical simplification of means in some cases and radical complexity and hermeticism in others can be understood as musical representations of disability conditions including deformity disfigurement mobility impairment madness idiocy and autism

richard strauss is an outlier in the context of twentieth century music some consider him a composer of the late romantic period while others declare him a traitor of modernity for his role in national socialism despite the controversy surrounding him strauss s works even beyond his most well known operas elektra and rosenkavalier are present in the repertoires of concert halls worldwide and continue to enjoy large audiences the details of the composer s life however remain shrouded in mystery and gossip laurenz lütteken s strauss presents a fresh approach to understanding this elusive composer s life and works dispensing with stereotypes and sensationalism it reveals strauss to be a sensitive intellectual and representative of modernity with all light and shade of the turn of the twentieth century
